Here' s a simple step-by-step guide for beginners:

- What is Mosaic Art?
- Mosaic art is made by arranging small pieces (tiles, glass, stones, paper, or mirrors) to create a design or picture.
- Materials Needed Base surface (cardboard, wooden board, MDF, clay pot, tray) Fevicol / white glue (for paper) or stone
- Old cloth or sponge, white cement (optional)

Steps to Make Mosaic Art

Step 1: Choose a Design

Draw a simple design (flower, leaf, bird, mandala, name) on your base using a pencil.

Step 2: Arrange First

Place the pieces of mirror without glue to see how they look.

Adjust spacing between pieces.

Step 3: Paste the mirror Apply

glue on the base.

Stick pieces one by one.

s

Leave small gaps between them.

Step 4: Drying

Let it dry for 6-12 hours.

Step 5: Grouting (Optional)

Mix grout or white cement with water.

Spread it over the mosaic to fill gaps.

Wipe excess grout with a damp cloth.

Let it dry completely.
