



SCHOOL HISTORY

In the year 1994, with the vision of contributing to the nation's greatest need—literacy for all—**Mr. Jagdish Singh Mathur**, the founder of **B.M. Bharti Model School, Rama Vihar, Majri, Delhi**, laid the foundation of the school. The foundation was laid in the presence of the Special Chief Guest, Late Sh. Sahib Singh Verma, former Labour Minister of the Government of Delhi. With the aim of promoting quality education, an educational society named Bhagat Memorial Bharti Educational Society was established. The school was recognized up to the middle level by the Directorate of Education, Delhi Administration, in its first academic session, (1994–95).



After ten years of sincere efforts, dedicated service, and outstanding academic results, the school was upgraded to the secondary stage in the year 2004 and received **affiliation** from the **Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Delhi**.

As the saying goes, “No obstacle can prevent excellence from reaching its highest height.” Continuing its journey of growth and achievement, the school was further upgraded in 2017. It was recognized by the Directorate of Education, Delhi, and affiliated with **CBSE, Delhi**, to run its own **Senior Secondary Classes**.

At present, the school offers three streams at the Senior Secondary level: **Science, Commerce, and Humanities**.
